



Long-Distance Moving Checklist

- ☐ Make sure you've submitted your change of address forms as soon as possible, and don't forget your subscription services.
- ☐ Sell or throw out items you no longer need. The fewer items you have, the lower the cost your move will be.
- ☐ Get moving quotes from at least 3 different companies or start pricing the cost of rental trucks and packing equipment if you're going DIY.
- ☐ Making arrangements to have utilities moved to your new home early. The last thing you'll want after a long drive is to find the WIFI isn't working.
- ☐ Pack a moving day bag that includes items you might need on night one at your new home and any vital documents you need to keep on your person during your move.
- ☐ When packing other boxes, label them by which room they belong in, which boxes are fragile, and which boxes need to be unpacked first when you reach your new home.
- ☐ Use a tool like our Moving Inventory Tracker or a physical notebook to keep track of every item you pack. After moving, check smoke detectors, change locks and explore your new neighborhood!
